## **SENATE BILL 2123**

## By Ketron

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 37; Title 38; Title 39 and Title 40, to enact the "Caylee Anthony Act" relative to children.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 37-10-202, is amended by designating the existing language as subsection (a) and by adding the following new subsections:

- (b) It is an offense for a parent physically able to do so to fail to make or knowingly refuse to make all reasonable efforts to report a missing child to the appropriate authorities in accordance with subsection (a) within twenty-four (24) hours of the time the parent knew, learned or believed that the child was missing.
- (c) Nothing in this section shall preclude prosecution and conviction of the parent, and any other person criminally responsible, for:
  - (1) Any applicable degree of homicide under title 39, chapter 13, part 2;
  - (2) Child abuse, child neglect or endangerment under § 39-15-401,
  - (3) Aggravated child abuse, aggravated child neglect or aggravated child endangerment under § 39-15-402;
    - (4) Reckless endangerment under § 39-13-103; or
    - (5) Any other applicable offense.
- (d) A parent who violates the provisions of subsection (b) commits a Class E felony.
- SECTION 2 . This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
